

How To Determine The Length Of A Boxed Chaise Cushion



A boxed chaise is essentially two cushions that are attached together with a fabric hinge or flap. This piece of fabric keeps both cushions in place on the chaise lounge frame.



The back portion of the chaise cushion is designed to sit on top of the seat portion. The final height of the back cushion will be "less the thickness" of the seat cushion.



Final chaise cushion back length (or height) equals length of the chaise back MINUS the thickness of the seat cushion.

FOR EXAMPLE - If the back of the chaise measures 34" From the top to where the seat starts, and the chaise seat is 4" thick, then you will need a 30" tall back cushion. If the seat of the chaise measures 50" from front to back, then you will need an overall cushion length of "80 inches with a hinge at 50".
